Growth







- > 5 in 2021 YTD
- > 868 Members, up 1 in the last quarter
- > 962 ASNs, up 43 in the last quarter
- Members are from 85 countries, up two in the last quarter



- > 270 100GE ports, up 16 in the quarter with 11 in provisioning
- 10GE ports have grown up to 1049 (up 48)
- Over 38.9Tbps of edge capacity (up 3Tbps this quarter vs 4.5Tbps previous quarter)

- Growth is continuing predominately in Manchester
 - > Including 100GE ports
- Traffic also growing at all IXP with Manchester new peak at 147Gbps (126Gbps)
- Several orders in provisioning for JEDIX
