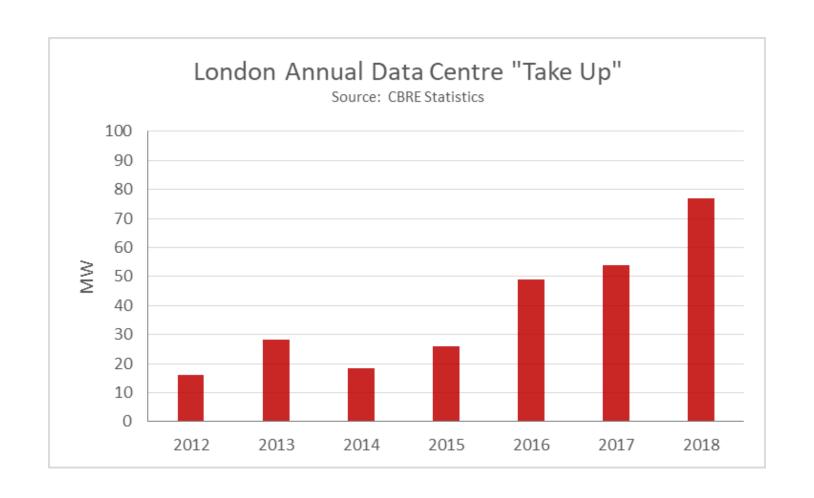

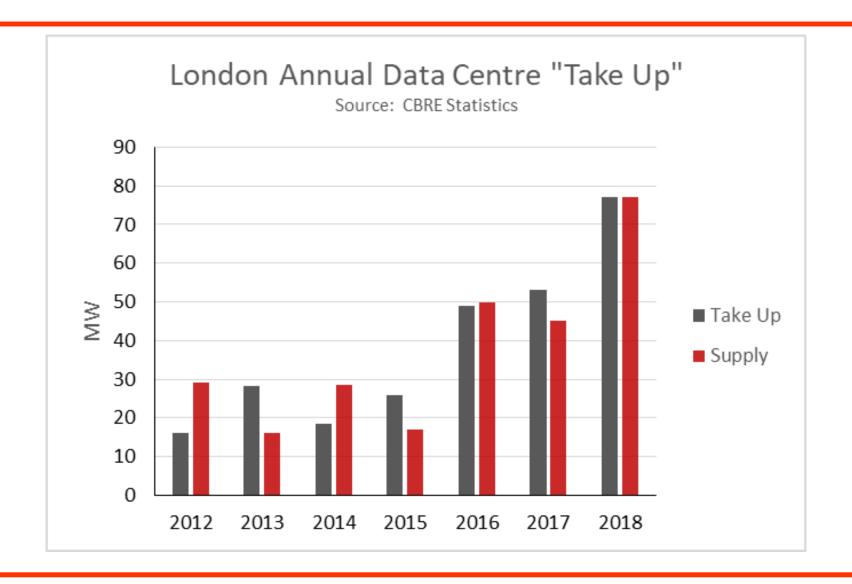
View in 2019: Recent changes – since 2015



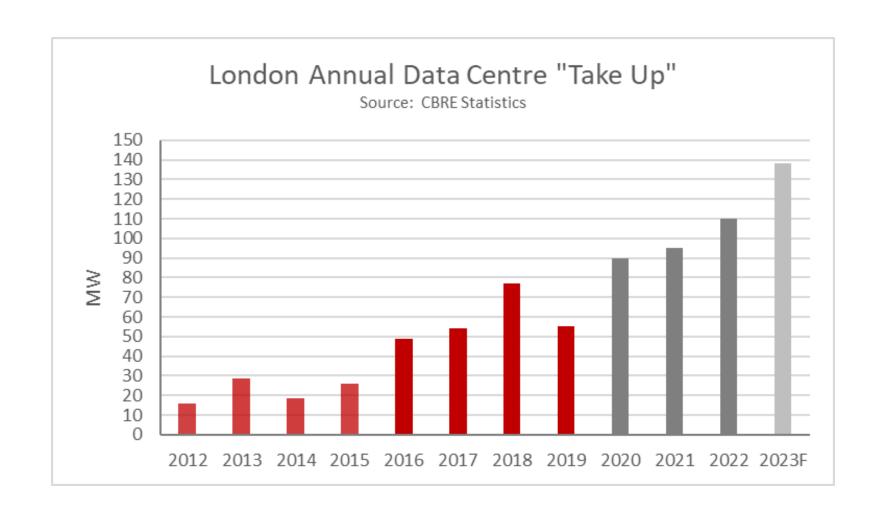

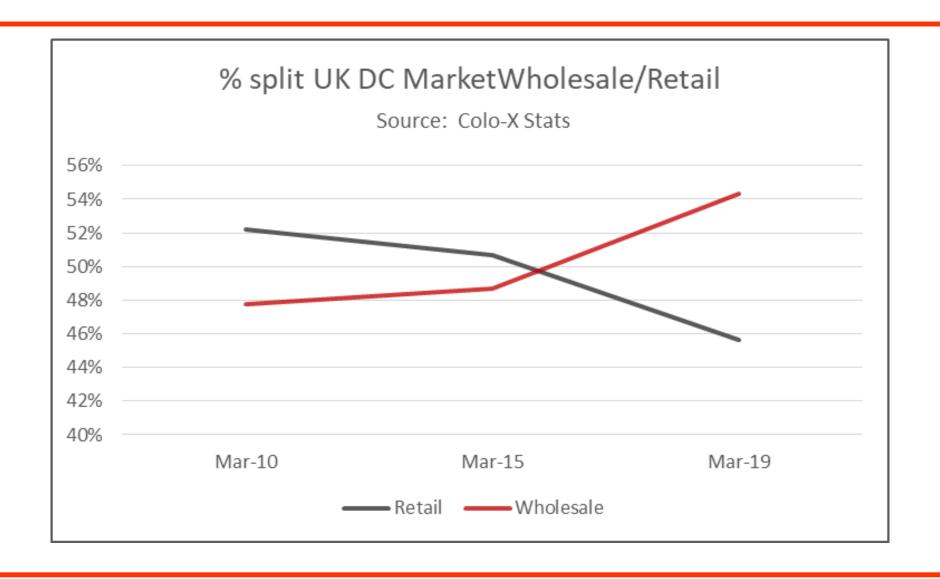






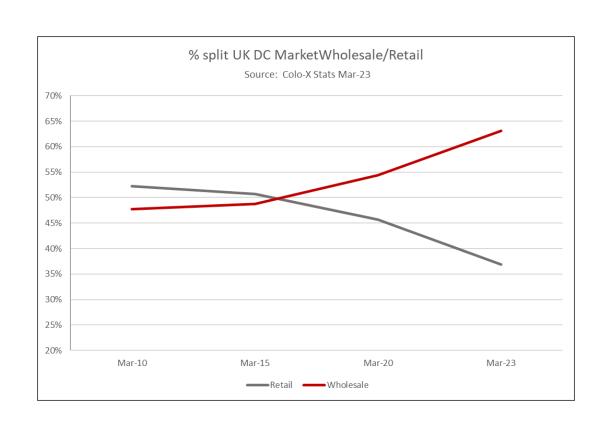
2019 - Evolution of UK's Data Centre Market

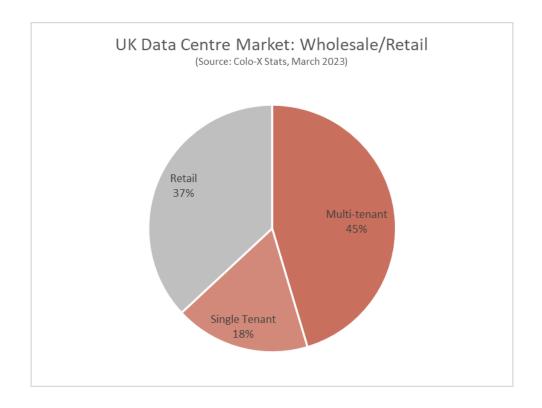




Update in 2023 – Wholesale Dominates







Update in 2023 – Will hyperscale and Wholesale continue?



Concerns:

- Cloud continues to grow, but at a slower rate
- Capex rates post pandemic also slowing
- Previous wholesale slowdowns have impacted retail colo market

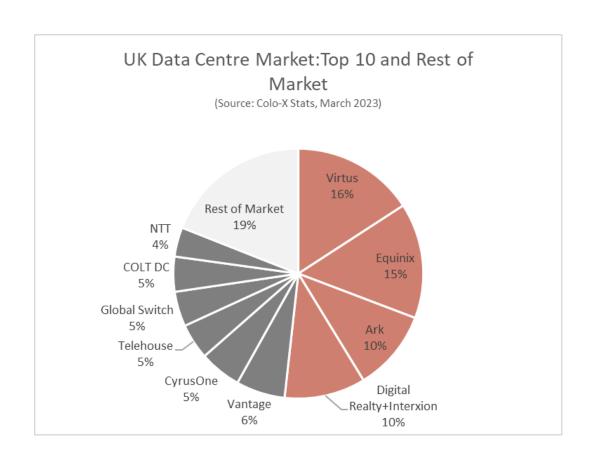
Bull Case:

- Market constraints:
 - Sites with power and planning
 - Personnel
 - Higher Interest rates = less supply, higher pricing?
 - Low vacancy rates

More GPU = more power = more heat

State of the UK Data Centre Market in 2023





- Colo-X DB = 140 sites, 1000MW, 50 operators
- Retail is expanding also! Almost exclusively in the REGIONAL market

Proximity Data Centres	10 facilities, 21MW	8 facilities are new to the UK colo market, two are acquisitions of existing sites
Telehouse South	5MW now, 15MW possible	Former Reuters data centre -re- opened in March 2022
Equinix MA5	First phase 6MW opened Q4 2022	MA6 next door to come, significant new capacity for UK Regional Market
AltasEdge (a new name, if not a new site)	Leeds/4MW	Acquired former Hardy Fisher site, expanding site to 4MW from 2

21 new facilities to Colo-X DC DB since March 2020

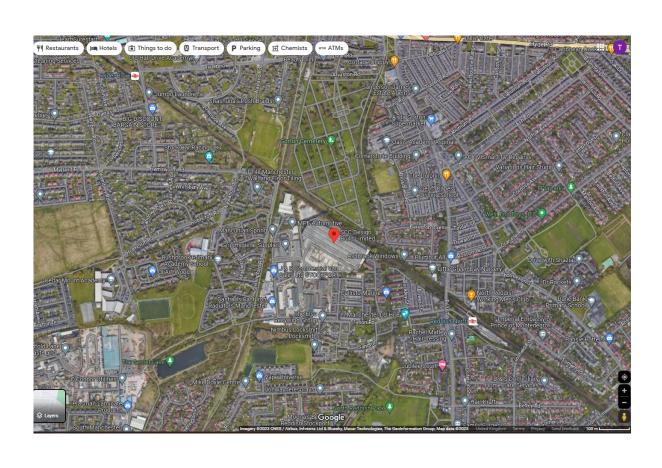
- 9 wholesale/8 single tenant/91MW

- Rest REGIONAL

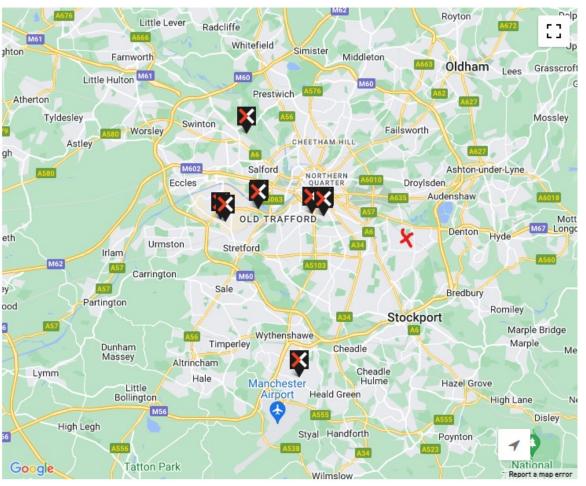

Kao Data Manchester – 40MW wholesale/market of 24MW

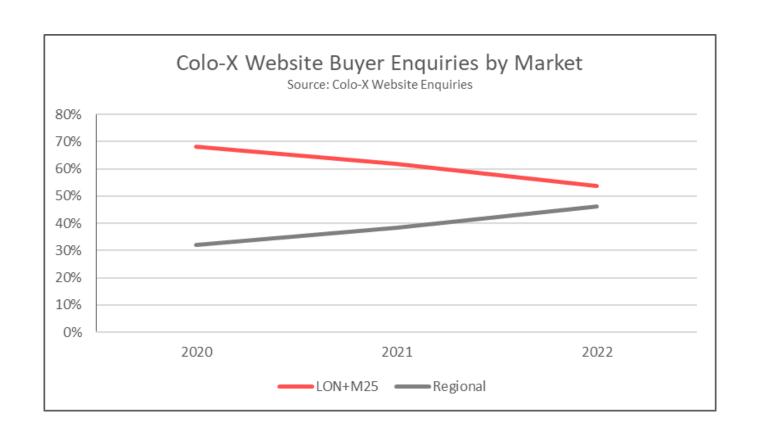






Growing Interest in Regional Colocation





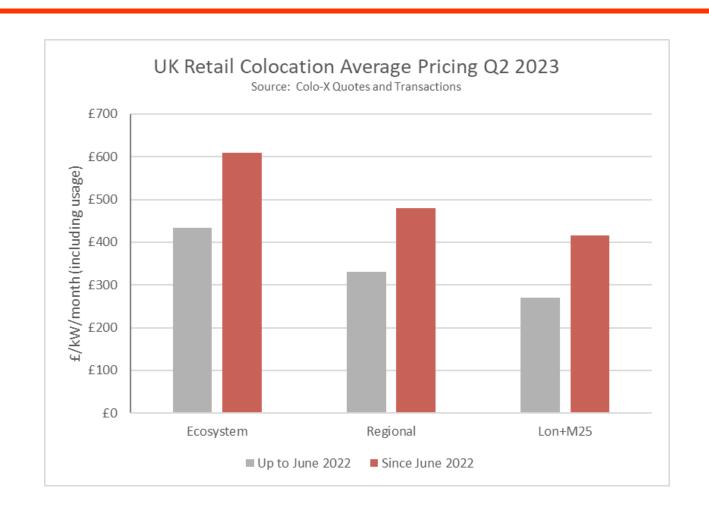
COLO Pricing: Slide from May 2019: LINX57 May 2007

- Verne merged with Volta, Digital9 Infrastructure plc
- Green Mountain former Infinity Romford, East London,40MW poss
- GTR/Yondr are large-scale hyperscale focus, Slough/West London, 40 and 100MW schemes
- Vantage NGD in 2020 (LINX), 2 new London dc's 48+20MW

Today's Market – EDGE new theme since 2019









- New "edge" focussed operators
- Proximity 10 sites, 25MW, big for regional market
- Atlas Edge UK and Europe
- Asanti 5 sites from Daisy
- Still early days for edge?

Summary – Growth Continues



- Hyperscale dominates headlines
- Single user sites
- Virtual "private market"
- Some questions over growth rates
- Offset by site/power scarcity, rising capital bar
- And Al.....
- Most in M25, but two regional wholesale sites

- Retail Colo also growing
- Most growth in the regional market "edge", not London
- 3 new edge focussed operators in UK
- Rising user interest but few "edge" cases yet
- Some London growth: Telehouse South,
 Equinix LD8 + LD7, DRT Cloud House
- Retail enquiries still strong, Colo-X website +20% ytd

2019 - Crosspoint now Amito - left in 2020, now Pulsant







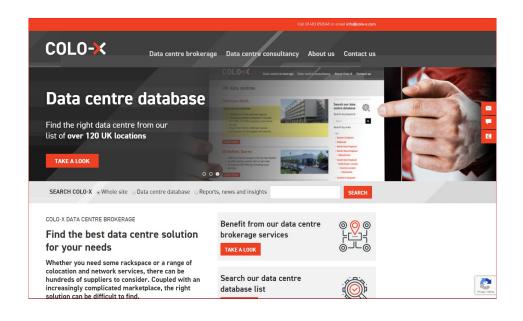




Today – Colo-X – No change!
