- We received the licensing for LINX Nairobi and went live at the end of the year.
- **Digital transformation**, a lot of work was done on self-service and member facing automation.
 - All port-based member SS and hybrid SS completed.
 - IX-API integrations implemented into LINX systems and tools for each relevant version.
 - IX-API with Cloud and MAPS implemented.
 - IX-API PVLAN, CUG services provisioning and cancellation with our OMS implemented.
 - The investment in self-service and automation can also be seen the uptake of usage of the self-service tools







- As well as in the shift from manual to usage of self-service we saw good results again from our membership survey.
 - A number of interesting member interviews were conducted to analyse Member Experience.
- Security
 - ISO27001 re-certification in August 2023.
- Products
 - MAPS has been deployed in NoVA and Manchester
 - Launch of Private VLANs between ports of the same member







Network & Capacity

- LINX Nairobi: Completed the new IXP build in Nairobi, the site is now live and covering the 3 data centres (IXAfrica, iColo and ADC).
- MA5 site: Completed the build of the 5th site in Manchester.
- OpenBGPd ideployed on Manchester, NoVA and LON2.
 - Enables us to have both route server platforms available for MAPS deployment, providing vendor resiliency as well as allowing us to deploy MAPS on existing OpenBGPd based route servers.
- NoVA redesign: Refreshes hardware to more cost-efficient Nokia solution, providing additional member connect capacity and ISL capacity between sites. Member migration in Q1-2024
- LINX Scotland is migrated to Edgecore/IPI solution from Extreme
- Core3-IN2 upgraded to facilitate 400G member growth.
- A lot of various ISL upgrades
- JEDIX capacity upgrade



 - Two resellers










• We track feedback on all our public ticket queues

LINX MoU.....








- May 2023: Vote on change to membership obligations

LINX MoU

- The LINX MoU has evolved over time through amendments, edits, changes etc
- Had some issues already from the start...
- The MoU serves as
 - Core part of our corporate governance
 - Our Terms and Conditions
 - Technical specification
 - Service specification
 - And to some extent part of our order form
- The MoU is also (or no longer) structured
 - In a way that makes dependencies or flows easy
- It lacks definitions and grouped clauses









- All of these issues makes the MoU hard to review, and change
- This increases the risk for oversights as we saw last year
- We are evaluating what the best action is to manage this




Strategy Sessions

- These are the exactly the same presentations as in August










LINX Strategy Process
