

MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

Qualifying Services Policy

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QUALIFYING SERVICES POLICY

Clause 2 of the LINX Membership Terms requires that LINX members make operational use of a “Qualifying Service” in order to sustain their membership. This document sets out which services count as “Qualifying Services”.

The “Qualifying Services” under this policy are:

- for all members, any of the services listed in Table 1; and
- for members joining through a LINX Channel Partner, any of the services listed in Table 1 or Table 2
